## Subject Specific Vocabulary

Features	Parts that make up a face.
Adult	A grown up person.

Community	A group of people living in the same place or area.

**We don't treat people differently because of the way they look.**

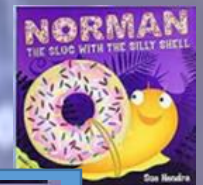
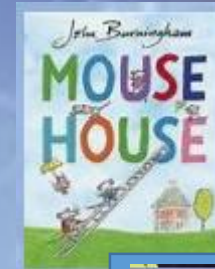
**All families are different and that's great!**
