Homework and Reading

- Homework will be given out on a Friday and will be asked to be returned no later than the following Wednesday.
- This year, every child will have an English and Maths homework book to take home. If they lose their book, they will need to pay £5 to replace it.
- If your child is having a 'wobble' with a question on their homework they can bring it in to school and we will go through it with them.
- Reading books will be given out in school. They will be changed twice a week. If the children lose their book, they will pay £2 to replace it.

PE Kit

- Class 13 and 14 will have PE on Tuesday Afternoon.
- Children are to arrive on Tuesday in their PE kit to avoid the need for getting changed.
- Please ensure that your child has the correct PE kit there is an illustration in your child's planner. It is a white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging trousers and plimsolls or trainers. No football kits.

- Reasoning Paper (Maths Paper 2)
- Reasoning Paper (Maths Paper 3)

There will be a Parent SATs Information evening nearer the time to talk about all things SATs.
